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HONOR SYSTEM BRANCHES

Honor Court

Members of the Honor Court consider matters of possible Honor Code violations in a hearing. Court Members ultimately decided whether the accused student is responsible for the violation in question and render appropriate sanctions if necessary.

AG Staff

Members of the Attorney General's Staff serve as counsels to reporting parties and accused students. Staff members assist in evidence collection and presentation, and work as a non-adversarial fact-finding body.

Honor System Outreach

Members of Honor System Outreach advocate for abiding by the Honor Code through widespread educational outreach. The Honor System Outreach members partner with students, faculty, and staff to provide information about Honor System procedures and policies.

Written letter of warning
Educational assignment

- Ask professors, staff, and TAs for guidance
- Practice effective time management

Conduct:

- Check building and facility hours of operation
- Plan transportation ahead
- Be mindful of power dynamics
- Walk away from escalating dangerous situations
